



## **C-2 Transportation Planner**

INCOG, the Metropolitan Policy Organization (MPO) for the Tulsa metropolitan area, is seeking qualified candidates for the position of Transportation Planner. The position is responsible for coordinating with area jurisdictions and agencies the development and implementation of current or prospective bike and pedestrian projects, assisting local communities with planning, development and implementation of comprehensive transportation strategies, and integrating transportation planning with land use policy and development.

Additional responsibilities include coordination of Transportation Resource Center (TulsaTRC.Org), project selection process for Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) seeking to implement active transportation projects, collaboration with Bikeshare implementation, and the "GO Plan" implementation, Regional master plan for bike & pedestrian infrastructure.

Further, this position will act as the project lead on special projects with programs such as Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) projects and/or other planning projects.

An accredited graduate degree in planning, geography, public administration or related discipline and three years of experience is preferred or an equivalent combination of education and experience. Candidates with experience in metropolitan transportation planning will be given priority in the selection process. Demonstrated use of Microsoft Office programs is required and exposure to Adobe Creative Suite, and interest in ESRI ArcGIS software is preferred.

INCOG offers a comprehensive benefits package, including retirement, medical, vision, and dental plans, and a deferred compensation plan. The position will have a starting annual salary range of \$45,000 to \$50,000, depending on the candidate's qualifications and experience.
