

**INTER-COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
FISCAL YEAR 2010 THRU 2011**

THIS INTER-COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT, made this 20 day of September, 2010, by and between the City of Sapulpa, State of Oklahoma (“City”) and the Board of County Commissioners of Creek County, State of Oklahoma (“Board”).

W I T N E S S E T H

WHEREAS, 70 O.S. Section 1001 et. seq., authorizes local governmental units to enter into agreements for joint and/or cooperative action; **and**

WHEREAS, 11 O.S. Section 22-101 and 19 O.S. Section 1 permits incorporated municipalities and counties within the State of Oklahoma to make contracts for the exercise of their corporate and administrative powers to provide services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to a form of governmental organization that will best accord with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; **and**

WHEREAS, the City and Board, being entitled to avail themselves of these statutory provisions, hereby deem it advisable for the Board to participate in the Comprehensive Planning Services and presently do so via the Sapulpa Metropolitan Area Planning Commission in accordance with O.S Title 19 Section 866 with the City.


NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and premises contained herein, the City and Board do hereby agree as follows:

1. The City of Sapulpa is updating the Sapulpa Comprehensive Plan (to be referred to as Plan Sapulpa); and
2. The plan is intended to manage growth and is intended to be a practical guide for making decisions on specific land use and development issues within the City’s Annexation Fence-line; and
3. Plan Sapulpa will help to prioritize governmental actions in the face of limited resources and can help public and private sectors to work in concert to build a better future for the Sapulpa Metropolitan Area; and
4. The plan’s study area included portions of unincorporated County within the City’s Annexation Fence-line; and
5. Cooperative planning is in the best interest public interest for both the County and the City, in particular for the unincorporated areas that lay within City’s annexation fence-line; and

6. The County agrees to participate in the development and preparation of said Plan and will cooperatively provide staff support and assistance from the Creek County Staff; and
7. The County agrees to assist with the cost of materials for in house publication of materials for the public hearing and document; and
8. The term of this Agreement shall be from year to year commencing on July 1, 2010 and continue in force until terminated by either party to the Agreement;

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that this Inter-Cooperative Agreement may be terminated by either party by furnishing a thirty (30) day written notice of said termination.


