

The paragraph below will be inserted into all significant publications that are distributed to the public, such as future versions and updates of the long-range transportation plan. The text will be placed permanently on the agency's website (www.incog.org) and in public areas of the agency's office, including the reception desk and meeting rooms. The version below is the preferred text, but where space is limited or in publications where cost is an issue, the abbreviated version can be used in its place.

The Indian Nations Council of Governments (INCOG) hereby gives public notice that it is the policy of the agency to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, Executive Order 12898 on Environmental Justice, and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which INCOG receives Federal financial assistance. Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with INCOG. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with INCOG's Title VI Coordinator/Public Outreach Planner within one hundred and eighty (180) days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
