**3. 2050 Regional Long Range Planning Process Update, Expansion of the Tulsa Transportation Management Area (TMA) & Public Involvement Process (PIP)**

INCOG as the Metropolitan Planning Organization is required to maintain a long range transportation plan (LRTP) with 20-year horizon that seeks to direct federal surface transportation investments and is required to update the plan every five years. Staff developed a framework to update the current LRTP, **Connected 2045** Plan. Staff will present next steps in that process that include expanding the Transportation Management Area and data development, and the updated Public Involvement Process (PIP) using the Public Participation Plan.

**4. Construction Management & Inspection on Local Public Agency (LPA) Projects**

INCOG has been working with local public agencies (LPAs) and Oklahoma Department of Transportation to mitigate construction management and inspection cost related impacts to locally sponsored projects to the extent possible. Staff is seeking input and direction from the LPAs, mainly from the Technical and Policy bodies of INCOG.

**5. Tulsa Area Trails Map Update**

INCOG developed a user friendly, foldable, pocket-size map showing Tulsa Area Trail connections and facilities. Staff will go over the map and the plan to make it widely available to area public and agencies.

INCOG has been involved with study and developing information related to regional broadband coverage and needs. Staff will provide the update; discuss issues and questions related to broadband coverage and availability in the region.
