INCOG received nine applications from seven entities for FY 2011-12 JARC/NF monies. Staff has completed the process of review and recommendation of projects for the award. Staff presented the summary to the Regional Council for Coordinated Transportation (RCCT), a voluntary council that serves in the advisory capacity to the Transportation Policy Committee to oversee the implementation of Human Services Coordination Plan. The RCCT reviewed these projects for conformity with the coordinated plan. Staff is recommending the attached projects for consideration by the Policy Committee for approval of grants for selected recipients.

4. Connections 2035 Regional Transportation Plan Update [pdf](#)

Connections 2035: Regional Transportation Plan update is in progress. Attached are two scenarios presented as 2035 alternatives for roadway transportation. First is the Base Network, a Do-Nothing Alternative(#1). Second is the current 2032 Plan as the Alternative #2. At the present time, Staff is seeking recommendations to develop an Enhanced Plan that accommodates the commitments and desires of the local implementing agencies to develop the DRAFT Roadway Plan as the Alternative #3. Once fully developed, each of these regional roadway alternatives will be tested for congestion, air quality, cost implications and other performance indicators.
