INCOG is required to develop annual work program in the form of UPWP, in coordination with the Metropolitan Tulsa Transit Authority and Oklahoma Department of Transportation. Attached is the proposed work program for the Fiscal Year 2021. Staff will review the FY2021 work program.

4. 918-Trails Branding Update

INCOG engaged a consultant to provide a framework for a collaborative regional signage template & designs for regional trails. The consultant working with stakeholders involving tribal, local entities and Riverparks Authority provided a design and implementation template. Staff will present recommendations from the study.

5. COVID-19 Effect on Transportation

INCOG will review its findings on average traffic volumes and transportation in general utilizing Streetlight on-line data. Vehicle miles driving in the region are tracked by staff that provides an indication of COVID-19 effect on travel patterns and air quality.
