3. 2050 Regional Long Range Planning Process Update & Expansion of the Tulsa Transportation Management Area (TMA)

INCOG as the Metropolitan Planning Organization is required to maintain a long range transportation plan (LRTP) that seeks to direct federal surface transportation investments and update the plan every five years. Staff has developed a framework to update the LRTP. In that process, staff will present a plan to expand the existing Tulsa TMA as the region continues to grow.

4. Construction Management & Inspection on Local Public Agency (LPA) Projects

INCOG has been engaged with local public agencies and Oklahoma Department of Transportation to discuss construction management and inspection cost related impacts to locally sponsored projects to the extent possible. INCOG developed a user friendly, foldable, pocket-size map showing Tulsa Area Trail connections and facilities. Staff will go over the map and the plan to make it widely available to area public and agencies.
