Four ODOT highway system projects were approved by the INCOG Executive Committee at their September 21, 2020 meeting. The three additional projects include a Tulsa Transit Bus and Bus Facilities grant, an ODOT project on SH-20 in Rogers County and the INCOG Congestion Management and Air Quality Program projects previously approved by the INCOG Board. A table summarizing the seven TIP amendment projects is included in the agenda packet. The INCOG Board has approved the attached TIP Amendments as well as ratified previously approved amendments, at the October 13, 2020 meeting.
