


# Civilian Noninstitutionalized Population with a Disability Concentrations within the Transportation Management Area

**Civilian Noninstitutionalized Population with a Disability**

**Index Value**

- Less than 1.00
- 1.00 to 1.99
- Greater than 2.00

Total civilian noninstitutionalized population within the TMA = 784,318

Total civilian noninstitutionalized population with a disability within the TMA = 105,712

Percent civilian noninstitutionalized population with a disability within the TMA = 13.48%

The index value is the comparison of the percent civilian noninstitutionalized population with a disability for the census tract to the same percentage of the civilian noninstitutionalized population with a disability for the whole TMA. The higher the index number the greater the concentration of the civilian noninstitutionalized population with a disability.
