This person will assist the department in all aspects of environmental sustainability including the development and implementation of water quality, air quality, alternative fuels and transportation, floodplain management, hazard mitigation, building efficiency, renewable energy, and other sustainability programs. Assist INCOG member jurisdictions with maintaining compliance with applicable laws and regulations, securing funding resources, and coordinating with those organizations and others to further the goals of sustainability in the Tulsa region.

The primary focus will be the design and implementation of water quality studies, plans, and programs related to the EPA's 604(b) Water Quality Education program and supporting the Green Country Stormwater Alliance with meetings, training, outreach and education, including assistance with maintaining websites and updating social media accounts.

The qualified candidate will have graduated from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in environmental science or other relevant programs is required. A minimum of three years' experience in water quality, sustainability, municipal government, or environmental law and regulations is preferred. Must possess a valid OK driver's license and have functional experience with Microsoft Office Suite and ArcGIS and preparing and sharing technical presentations.
