The candidate will assist with running our data through the Oklahoma Toolkit for submission to the state repository on a quarterly basis. Other duties include the ability to prepare parcel-based maps, perform parcel data queries and editing and maintaining GIS layers in an SDE format. Additional responsibilities include assisting with special mapping projects, mapping support for in-house staff, member communities, public organizations, and the general public. The candidate will work with our member communities and community planners on a variety of projects, including but not limited to comprehensive plans.

Candidates must possess a Bachelor's degree in Geography, Earth Sciences or a closely related field with emphasis on GIS; or successful completion of a college-level GIS Certificate program. ESRI ArcGIS Pro experience is required. Knowledge of legal descriptions, cartography, and aerial photography a plus. We are seeking applicants with 3 to 5 years' experience using ESRI ArcGIS desktop or ArcGIS Pro.
